FANCHER WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL Route 31 Hamlet of Fancher, Orleans County, New York

The Landmark Society recognizes the Town of Murray, with appreciation and gratitude, for the restoration of the Fancher World War II Memorial. The memorial is a monument to 10 young men from the Fancher community who were killed in World War II. The restoration of this highly visible memorial was achieved via a remarkable partnership of town government, the Murray-Holley Historical Society, and Dr. Fred Fiorito, a former Fancher resident/philanthropist. With repairs completed by local craftsmen, the Medina stone tower, with clock, was re-dedicated in August, 2021, exactly 72 years after its original dedication. For your significant commitment to historic preservation via this unique community project, The Landmark Society honors the Town of Murray.
